




Pathways in aged care

2013-14

90% of people who entered residential care in 2013-14 had used aged care services previously



People living in Major cities moved an average of 39kms, compared with

over 400kms

for people living in remote and

very remote areas





People with

carers were more likely to move less than 10km to enter residential care
